



Well, the Ships Operations Manual Review Committee continues its work on looking at how we are organized, and working to update things, revise procedures, and clarify wording. A new Role Playing Game is starting soon! The USS Matrix has been tasked to investigate and pursue Orion Pirates operating in Federation Space. The game itself has five parts; an intro, where the full scenario is explained and assignments made, and four action sequences. The last one will be the Grand Finale, and wrap up this particular story line. Folks can post actions and background from their perspective as members of the crew. If you want to team with others, that's great! Just be sure to coordinate if you use other crew members in your writeups. More details will be posted to the list prior to the start of the game.

FCAPT Matt Haley is working on reviving our Internet Starfleet Academy. This Academy was started as a resource for our non-SFI members. SFI has an extensive Academy (shameless plug to join SFI), but we thought having our own Academy to supplement the SFI one, would be nice. Matt is asking all Directors of Colleges to please send him course descriptions, tests, and test keys so he can keep them in a central location. I'd also ask that if any crew member has old copies of tests from the ISFA, that you email Matt and tell him what you have. A number of Colleges have gone missing due to crew members leaving the ship (notably Operations and Science courses), so if you have an old test, Matt wants to hear from you!
