These can be used for Promotion purposes, so check it out!

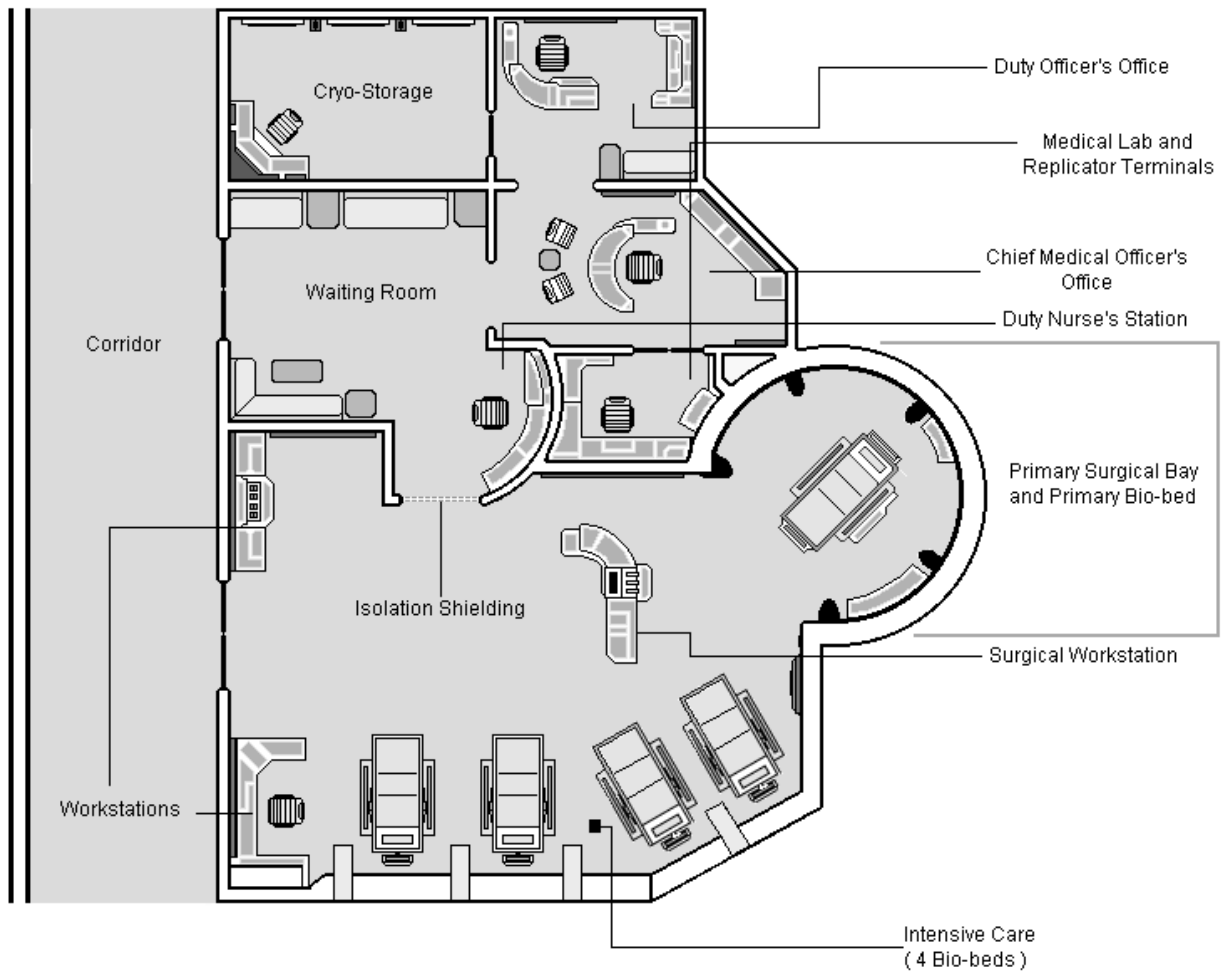

## MEET THE MATRIX



**Gabriel Class Main Sickbay**

Cryo-Storage is used to hold corpses, dangerous and benign bio-specimens for storage, and hot tempered Marines (just kidding guys!)

The Duty Officer's Office has access to scheduling, patient records, and current bio-readouts for any inpatients. Other miscellaneous work can be done there as well.

The medical lab is used to run medical tests for diagnostic purposes and to perform some experiments. Replicator terminals are used to make food, drugs and anything not larger than a bread box that sickbay may need.

The Chief Medical Officer's Office is the hub of sickbay. Major research, scheduling, meetings, consultations, and more all take place there.

'The Intercom' newsletter managed to snatch an exclusive interview with the newly-appointed XO as she paused only to drink her regulation water. The Matrix computer is exhibiting signs of stress as it tries to keep up with Commander Haywood, her location changing from minute to minute as she darts from department to department, her sleeves rolled up, her face alight with enthusiasm and her blood fizzing. Unfortunately, playback revealed only a blank; the recording device failed to preserve the interview, as Commander Haywood was too fast for it.

If you go to the home page of the USS Matrix [website](#), you will see that one of the crewmembers is a librarian. Commander Haywood is that librarian. Not the sort you will find in a public library, who date-stamps your loaned books, but our new XO deals with instruction manuals for military aircraft (how to build a helicopter and so on). She is comfortable with targs; this may be because her RL father used to train police dogs, it may also be because her RPG backstory includes seven years spent in the Klingon Empire when an Officer Exchange Program went wrong.

**MATRIX UNIVERSITY NOW OPEN !!!**

On 11<sup>th</sup> July 2007, the Matrix University opened its virtual doors. FCAPT Matt Haley describes it this way: "The new website is at <http://mu.usmatrix.org> <<http://mu.usmatrix.org/>> . (It can also be reached via links on every page of the ussmatrix.org website.)

The Matrix University (MU) was designed to provide a chance for Non-Starfleet Members to learn more about the Trek World. These courses may also be used for promotional credit on the USS Matrix.

Each Division of the USS Matrix is encouraged to develop a course of study for their particular area. Each curriculum has a Director, who acts as a point of contact and maintains a web page with the requirements for that particular course of study.

The degree programs include course work, which may be used for partial or full promotional credit. Other programs require the completion of entry exams as well as additional course work for advancement through the degree programs of Bachelors (BA or BS), Masters (MA or MS) and Doctorate (PhD). The different degree programs must be completed in order and may be completed by e-mail; some PhD programs may require the use of Galactic Snail Mail (Postal Service)."
